

Grants for Irrigation Demos and Trials

Have you been doing something for years that really works but you don't have evidence/data to back up what you see on farm?

Have you wanted to trial something new, that hasn't been done locally before?

Are you interested in trialing emerging technologies on your farm?

Applications for new irrigation demo trials are about to open.

All irrigators in the Lake Wellington catchment (Central Gippsland) are eligible.

Up to \$27,000 per project available.

Your project must broadly achieve one or more of the following:

- reduce nutrient runoff into the Gippsland Lakes.
- contain impacts of salinity
- encourage regional economic growth
- improve understanding of social and cultural values
- or reduce greenhouse emissions from irrigated agriculture

Projects must be started by 30 June 2022 and be fully completed and signed off by 30 March 2024.

HOW TO APPLY

Expressions of Interest to be received by **4pm Friday 18th March**.

Register your interest by calling Agriculture Victoria's irrigation team. Agriculture Victoria will then assist you in completing a more detailed application form and conduct a site visit.

Up to \$27,000 worth of funding available to assist with the project. Only one grant available per business.
